What a year 2020 has been so far! To continue raising money for Riverside school, the Friends of Riverside School are launching their 100 Club. Register now to secure your number. You have to be in it to win it!

Here's how it works... each month three numbers will be drawn from the bag. 1st prize will get £50, 2nd prize of £20 and 3rd prize £10 for 11 out of 12 months<sup>1</sup>. Each December, as a Christmas special, all prizes double for one month only<sup>2</sup>.

The Friends of Riverside School 100 Club is a private lottery and is open to all parents, grandparents, carers, teachers, staff and friends of Riverside School. Anyone age 16 or over can join. Places will initially be limited to 2 per household, with a waiting list in operation.

To join simply complete the attached membership form and set up a Standing Order for £24 annually (preferred) £2 a month. This buys you one number (we will allocate), and enters you into the monthly draw.

The 100 Club will take place on the last Friday of each month **starting on Friday 25 September 2020**. The deadline for the first draw has been extended to Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> September, so please submit your application form now.

If you win, your prize money will be paid either by BACS or cheque (posted to your home address) and the name of the winners published in the school's regular newsletter and on the school's website.

**All** profit from the 100 club will go towards our school to help fund equipment, resources and new opportunities for pupils, so please, if you can, we would very much welcome your support.

## Friends of Riverside School

### 100 CLUB RULES

#### PURPOSE

The purpose of the 100 Club is to raise funds. The money will be paid into the Friends of Riverside School bank account and used to meet funding requests from the school, providing equipment, resources and opportunities for pupils.

#### RULES

1. For a cost of £2 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated one number between 1 and 100.
2. A draw will be made every month with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize.
3. The prizes will total 40% of the annual income.
4. This will be apportioned as: 1st prize of 25% (£50<sup>3</sup>), 2nd prize of 10% (£20<sup>1</sup>) and 3rd prize of 5% (£10<sup>1</sup>) for 11 out of 12 months. The prizes for December will be higher with a 1st prize of 50%, 2nd prize of 25% and 3rd prize of 15% of the monthly income.
5. The 100 Club is a private lottery and is open to all parents, grandparents, carers, teachers, staff and friends of Riverside School. Anyone age 16 or over can join.
6. Numbers are limited to two per household to ensure as wide a participation as possible. A reserve list will be held and spare numbers filled during October if required.
7. Payments must be made by standing order (preferably annually) or annual cheque. One month's notice is required for cancellation.
8. Member's numbers will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
9. If a member has no valid reason for missing a payment, their number may be sold to someone on the reserve list.
10. The draw shall be made by the Head Teacher in the last assembly each month, or an alternative should social distancing not allow assemblies to continue.
11. Prizes will be paid via BACS within one week of each draw wherever possible. Payment by cheque can be requested.
12. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted in the school newsletter and on the school website.
13. The 100 Club will be run by Friends of Riverside School. In case of any dispute the decision of the Committee is final.
14. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the 100 Club if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month.
15. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into the Friends of Riverside School funds after six months.
